

Paint & Non-Skid System Product Primer: Seaguard 5000 Universal Primer Epoxy Filler (for repairs): Steel Seam FT-910 Non-Skid Coating: American Safety Ms-375G Top Coat: Sherloxane 800 Solvent / Thinner MEK reducer / cleaner Misc consumables - roller/brushes/grind pads

Paint & Non-Skid System Particulars

# Congratulations to New Association Secretary Jill Michel


At the Annual

# Laffey Movie Update Destroyer: Hell from the Heavens






There are two potential Laffey movies. The first is Destroyer: Hell from the Heavens. The second is Typhoon of Steel (below).

My father used this when he did lectures at area high schools in Northern Virginia. The flag in front of the ship, per my father, flew on the Randolph the day of Glenn's historic flight in 1962.
